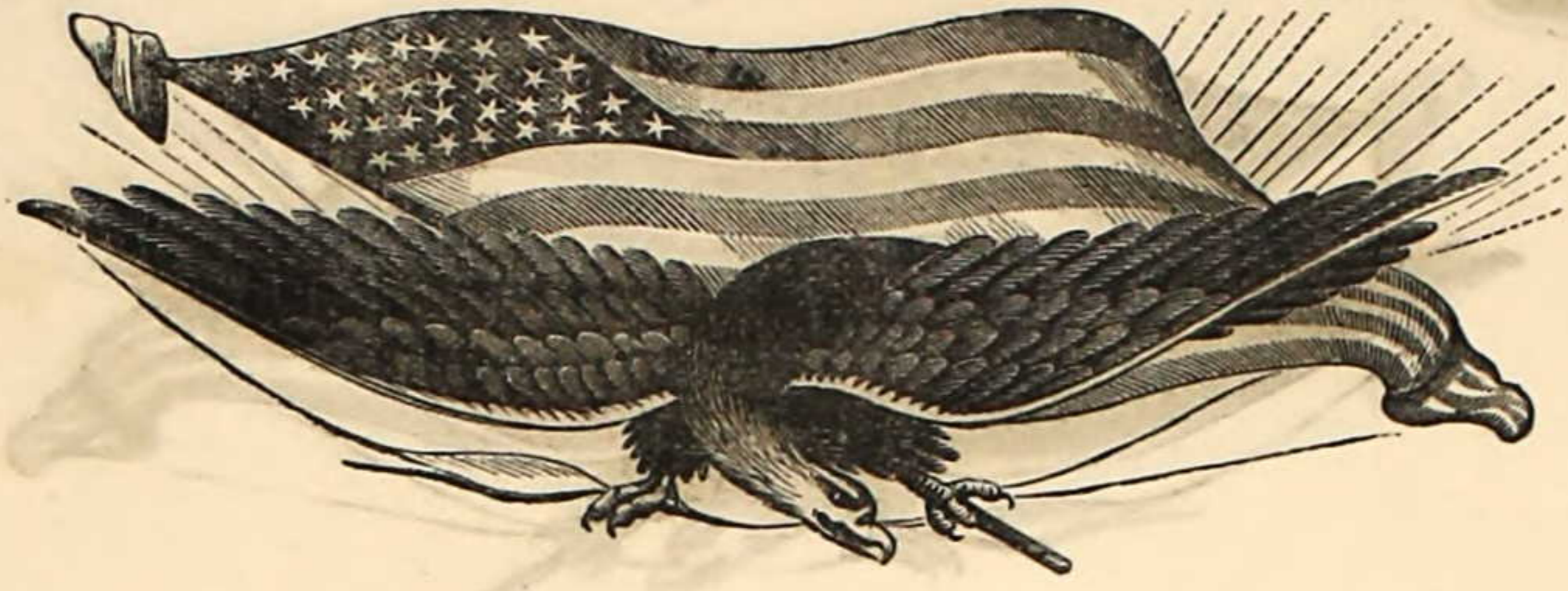


UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.



Eastern District of the State of Louisiana,
CITY OF NEW ORLEANS.

To Wit:

At a Stated Session of the District Court of the United States of America, held in and for the Eastern District of the State of Louisiana, on the Fourth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Sixty-four Present, the Honorable EDWARD H. DURELL, Judge thereof:

Be it Remembered, that, on the said day, personally appeared in open Court Vicente Prieto an Alien, and Native of the Kingdom of Spain and made application to be admitted a Citizen of the United States of America; and thereupon the said Applicant exhibited to the Court a certified copy of a declaration made by him in the State of Louisiana in order to become a Citizen of the United States, on the Second day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Fifty-nine

And it being Proven, to the satisfaction of the Court, on the oaths of Juan Ferris and Juan Sanchez both Citizens of the United States of America, that the said Applicant has resided within the limits, and under the jurisdiction of the United States of America, for upwards of five years immediately preceding the date of his application, and within the State of Louisiana, where this Court is now holden, for more than one year; and it being proved that he has behaved as a man of good moral character, attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States of America, and well disposed to the good order and happiness of the same.

And it further appearing to the Court, upon the testimony aforesaid, that the said Applicant has not borne an Hereditary title, or been of any of the orders of Nobility, in the said Kingdom of Spain And it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that the said Applicant has in all respects fulfilled the requisites, and is entitled to the benefits of the Acts of Congress, relative to Naturalizations, and the said Applicant having declared on oath, before this Court, that he will support the Constitution of the United States of America, and that he doth forever renounce and abjure all Allegiance and Fidelity to every Foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereignty, whatever, and particularly to the Queen of Spain of whom he was a subject

It was thereupon Ordered and Adjudged, by the Court, that the said Vicente Prieto be admitted, and he is accordingly admitted by said Court, to be a Citizen of the United States of America.
